

# Southwest Ohio's Scenic Bike-Hike Trails

Welcome to Southwest Ohio's Scenic Rails-Trails and River Trails now totaling over 237 miles that are connected paved as non-motorized and shared use paths meandering through nine counties from Milford to Urbana, west to Verona and east to beyond London. There are connections to: the new Lebanon Countryside Trail; Simon Kenton Trail and Buck Creek State Park in Springfield; to Creekside Trail through Beavercreek, Eastwood Park, the Great Miami River Trail, Wolf Creek Recreation Trail, Stillwater River Recreation Trail and the Mad River Recreation Trail in Dayton; the Ohio to Erie Trail to London and beyond to Wilson Road near Lilly Chapel.
